The 31st Annual Atlantic Undergraduate English Conference

on

March 16-18, 2012

This conference is a chance for undergraduate English students to travel to Fredericton to present their academic papers or creative writing to their peers from the region.

Presentations should take 15 minutes to present; that is, be about 7 to 10 typed, double-spaced pages long.

Process:

Submit papers/creative writing to your departmental advisor, who will expedite choosing 4 scholarly papers and 2 creative writing pieces for presentation at the conference.

February 15th: *for the departments to send to STU*

- 250 word (max) abstracts of the chosen papers/creative writing, WITH TITLES and
- 50 word biographies of the presenters

Academic papers may address, but are not limited to, contemporary and/or historical literature; regional or national literatures; post-coloniality; specific writers; genre writing; literary theory, etc.

Creative writing submissions may include poetry, prose, scripts, and/or any hybrids thereof, or anything else that can be read aloud in 15 minutes.
