Titre du stage : The POP (Pediatrics on Princess) Centre Registry
1. Description du projet de recherche Community Social Pediatrics is an interdisciplinary “kitchen table” approach to pediatric care. Our clinic brings children, caregivers, and professionals together to help mitigate the impact of the social determinants of health and eliminate any other barriers that prevent children from thriving. The POP Centre registry collects data directly from children and families who have been referred to the POP Centre. This registry will help support an analysis on the status of children’s rights and associated health as well as social outcomes of children whose rights are not being fulfilled. The implications this approach could have on these children may include short-term benefits as well as a more inclusive picture of the child’s risk factors. This will allow professionals to intervene in a timely manner and government decision makers to implement evidence-based policies which consider children’s rights.

Description des tâches attitrées à l’étudiante ou l’étudiant Data Collection & Management - Assist with data entry into the research registry. - Review and validate data for accuracy and completeness. - Help organize participant information while maintaining confidentiality. Literature Review & Research Support - Conduct literature reviews on topics related to youth substance use and registry methodologies. - Summarize key findings from research papers. - Assist in creating reference lists and managing citations. Analysis & Reporting - Assist with basic data analysis (if trained) under supervision. - Help draft preliminary reports on registry findings. - Create infographics or summary documents for stakeholders.
3. Description des modalités de supervision The student will actively participate in all team meetings and training sessions to stay informed about the research process and contribute to discussions. Regular check-ins will be conducted by both the Supervisor and the Research Manager to provide guidance, address any challenges, and ensure the student’s integration into the research team. The student will receive ongoing feedback on their work, including data collection, literature review, and other assigned tasks, to support their learning and professional development. Supervision will be adapted based on the student’s progress and needs, fostering a structured yet supportive environment for skill-building in research methodology and ethical practices.
