

Following is the missing artists-researchers profiles: Jean-Denis Boudreau: 35, father of one, 5'9", 165 lbs, black hair, green eyes, lives and works in Moncton. Sobey Art Award finalist in 2007, he searches for solutions to today's problems and difficulties through the transformation of recycled materials. Paul Bossé, 39, father of one, 5'11", 185 lbs,

brown hair, hazel eyes, lives and works in Moncton. Poet, playwright and filmmaker, he invents a parallel world full of rhythms and effrontery.

At the time of their disappearance, both were wearing glasses and lab coats.

Artistic authorities suspect the abduction may have been motivated by the arcane and potentially revolutionary researches in USDhD (Ultra Super Duper hyper Definition) led by Boudreau and Bossé.

According to some, the first successful public demonstration of the prototype at Moncton City Hall on September 28, 2010 could have attracted the attention of interested parties in the field. These same parties would have been conscious of the extreme technological, if not to say metaphysical, potential of the discovery.

Young-Maxwell solicits the community's assistance, exhibiting the remnants of the scientific and artistic research that has led to Boudreau and Bossé's mysterious disappearance. It is hoped that clues will emerge and enable firstly, to find the missing inventors, and secondly, to reconstruct the damaged prototype.

Tim Travis, controller at Young-Maxwell, will be present at the gallery to exchange information on Wednesday, November 10, from 5 PM to 7 PM.

Galerie d'art Louise et Reuben-Cohen is located at 405 Université Avenue, in the Clément-Cormier building on the Université de Moncton campus.
