UNIVERSITÉ DE MONCTON FINE ARTS GRADUATES' SHOW

MONCTON, April 3 2012 – From April 13 to May 27 2012, Galerie d'art Louise et Reuben-Cohen presents an exhibition of works by Université de Moncton graduating fine arts students. The opening will be held on **Thursday**, **April 13**, **between 7 and 9 PM**, with the graduating students in attendance.

Ten graduating students will be presenting their work. Alisa Arsenault (Moncton) explores the (de/re) construction of identity by means of photography, video, audio, installation and homemade craftsmanship. Valérie Aucoin-Laflamme (Acadian peninsula/Dieppe) presents the everyday with a twist in her photographs. Through ceramic sculptures, Vanessa Bezeau (Petit-Shippagan) tackles the questions of physical and environmental health. Cynthia Gagnon's (Grand-Barachois) sculptures present diverse human psychological states. Joey Robin Haché (Bathurst/Moncton) is a musician who is also interested in painting, etching and drawing. In sculpture, Mario LeBlanc (Saint-Antoine) creates contemplatives spaces that reflect current society. In her photographic and sculptural works, Renée-Claude Marquis (Edmundston) takes an interest in nature and in the effects of industrialization. Françoise Morin (Shippagan) composes transcriptions of musical scores by way of shapes and color. Christine Pitre (Bathurst) reflects on society and on the traces left behind. Geneviève Sivret (Ste-Marie-St-Raphaël) is guided by the principle that «man is a social animal» in her photographs and etchings.

Galerie d'art Louise et Reuben-Cohen is located at 405 Université Avenue, in the Clément-Cormier building on the Université de Moncton campus. Gallery hours are 1 PM to 4:30 PM, Tuesday to Friday, and 1 PM to 4 PM on Saturday and Sunday. Admission is free.
