**3/3: UNIVERSITÉ DE MONCTON 2014 FINE ARTS GRADUATES' SHOW**



**Moncton, March 31 2014** – The Louise and Reuben Cohen Art Gallery presents an exhibition of works by Université de Moncton's graduating fine arts students titled **3/3**. The opening will be held on **Friday, April 11 2014, between 7 and 9 PM**, with the three graduating students in attendance.

**Emanuelle Baril** is from Princeville in Québec and proposes print and photographic work that relate to identity through the use of memory and recollections.

From Grande-Digue, **Nicole Rita Bourgeois** explores the body's response to emotion and reveals the paradox between positive and negative thinking in both painting and ceramics.

Personal space, abstraction, reflection and movement form the basis of photographic and print-based projects by **Claire Tauvette**, of Ottawa.

The exhibition will be presented until June 1 2014. The Louise and Reuben Cohen Art Gallery is located at 405 Université Avenue, in the Clément Cormier building on the Université de Moncton campus.
