## UNIVERSITÉ DE MONCTON 2015 FINE ARTS GRADUATES' SHOW



MONCTON, April 7, 2015 – The Louise and Reuben Cohen Art Gallery presents an exhibition of works by Université de Moncton's graduating fine arts students. The opening will be held on Friday, April 17 2015, between 7 and 9 PM, with the four graduating students in attendance.

In her paintings, **Claudie Landry**, from Shédiac, is interested in deconstructed narration, creating juxtaposed assemblages of recognizable objects of incongruous and destabilizing proportions. With printmaking, she explores the repetition of motifs in a composition where the support is an integral part of the image.

From Dieppe, **François Bordeleau** proposes architectural ceramic work where simplicity

and geometry leave room for the viewer's interpretation.

Born in Québec of Acadian descent, **Marie-France Robichaud** is interested in inhabited space and territories while analysing the change of home of three individuals. In her ceramic work, she explores the human condition with humour and pathos, comparing the classical and contemporary eras, both oriented toward excess.

In both sculpture and printmaking, **Jennifer-Anne Rousselle**, of Tracadie-Sheila, is engaged in social critique. She stages scenarios that bring the viewer to question his or her role in society.

The exhibition will be presented until May 31, 2015. The Louise and Reuben Cohen Art Gallery is located at 405 Université Avenue, in the Clément-Cormier building on the Université de Moncton campus. Gallery hours are 1 PM to 4:30 PM, Tuesday to Friday, and 1 PM to 4 PM on Saturday and Sunday. Admission is free.
