



Rotchild Choisy is an emerging multidisciplinary artist from Haiti.

His artistic work focuses on the social, economic and political relationships that people have with their environment.

**Kimberley Vallillee** is originally from Grand Falls, New Brunswick. She studied for 5 years in Visual Arts with a teaching orientation at the Université de Moncton. In short, her photographic work explores identity through the representation of women in our Western society.

**Savannah Beaupré** is originally from Saint-Léonard, New Brunswick. She holds a Bachelor of Visual Arts with a teaching orientation from the Université de Moncton (2020) and was the recipient of the Sheila Hugh Mackay Foundation Merit Scholarship. Working primarily with family photos and childhood memories, her exhibition project explores her family ties, her hometown, her family home, and her attachment to these.

The graduating students' exhibition will be on display until May 29, 2022, and is presented by the Department of Visual Arts at the Université de Moncton. The gallery is open from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. from Tuesday to Sunday. Admission is free and open to all.
